DAVE BOWERLY-former Senior Class President and today a man of initiative for this '76 Class Reunion-is in fact the only one of you who took the chance in 1967 to see me in Germany. Having been an unbound and lonesome but really not shy guy in those days, he

experienced new situations and I wish everyone of you could have similar cultural stimuli. Just ask him a few questions about "black-riding" in a street car, the hitch-hiking girls with their as he thought "low barriers" and the German ducks that don't speak English he'll tell you. I hope our mutual friendship will continue growing.

ENERGY is what you need when you want to forster friendship, social and political activities and when you worry about your job. Unemployment is right now a severe problem especially for many young people who are not put into a position of finding an adequate place of education to assure a happy and meaningful future.

And I still enjoy travelling to other countries trying to learn other people's problems and feelings. My trips led me so far also to Isreal, Russia, Austria, Itlay, Yugoslavia, Hungary, Switzerland, Denmark, France. This summer we hope to visit ancient Persia-another fascinating area. My hobby is to produce not only colorful slides but also-if I have time enough-tapes with corresponding texts and background music. Creative reminiscences!!

BEHAVIOR AND BROTHERHOOD are words people don't like to hear-not only in the private sphere but also in politics. A young man was lying next to the curb in Zurich at night; his drug addiction brought him physical (and Mental?) collapse. The mass walked by distrgarding him with a shy look. Politicians-do they care for their people? The Governor of Baden-Wurttemberg Filbinger fought the social-democratic party (SPD) with the alternative "Freedom or Socialism" in the last elections. President Ford's campaign managers and strategists advise him to abandon public question-and-answer-sessions after his primary losses in Indiana, etc. Mr. Reagan should be pictured now as a dangerous and unelectable reactionary. Two levels: do you find a hint for a prologue to understanding? Privateness and ideological thinking are the key works of our time. (You certainly have also heard of the CIA's activities?!)

RELIGION is in fact one answer to this moral dilemma. It is my conviction that through the Christian Faith we have a chance to wrestle down such developments in society. However setbacks are possible. This is one reason why I eventually became a conscientious objector and worked in a hospital for 18 months instead of serving in the armed forces. DETERMINATION AND DESTINY are two aspects that belong together in our lives. I honestly hope that you reached your personal goals and those that are yet to come. Have a happy reunion!
